Local Governing Body Member Roles & Responsibilities

- Support and constructively challenge school leaders to maintain high standards of teaching, learning and wellbeing.
- Champion the Trust's values of Vitality, Integrity, Togetherness and Aspiration within the local school community.
- Monitor areas such as pupil achievement, safeguarding, attendance, and inclusion.
- Act as a link between the Trust Board and the local community celebrating success and raising aspirations.
- Uphold good governance practice and contribute to the strategic direction of the school within the framework set by the Trust.

Time Commitment

- Around 4–8 hours per term for meetings, preparation, and school visits.
- Typically 3–6 meetings per year, held at school or online.
- Full training and induction provided, plus opportunities to develop governance and leadership skills.
- A four-year term of office (renewable).
- Enhanced DBS check and safeguarding training required.
